What data we gather

We may collect the following information:

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide our company with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

Cookies and how we use them

What is a cookie?

Third Party Cookies

- **Social Media Networking** - Social media cookies allow users to interact more easily with social media, such as Facebook and Instagram. We do not control social media cookies and they do not allow us to gain access to your social media accounts.
